### **MATTHEW 26:57 - ACTS 6:7**

1. As you read your Bible this week, which particular thought(s) and event(s) stood out to you or surprised you? What questions came up that you would like to find the answers to?
2. In what ways has your reading of the Old Testament enhanced your understanding of the events and people you are reading about in the New Testament?
3. Why is the death and resurrection of Jesus so important? What did his death and resurrection accomplish for all of mankind?
4. What do the Gospels reveal about the humanity and deity of Jesus?
5. What are some of the statements that Jesus made about himself? What are the significance of these statements?
6. What are some of the truths that Jesus repeatedly tried to teach his disciples, but that they just didn't seem to "get"?
7. After his resurrection, Jesus commanded his disciples to go into the entire world and do what? Do you think that commandment holds true for us today?
8. What was the significance of the events spoken about in Acts chapter 2? What miraculous ability did the Holy Spirit give to the disciples on the day of Pentecost that allowed everyone to understand the gospel message on that day?
