Hebrews 11:23-27 (NIV)

By faith Moses' parents hid him for three months after he was born, because they saw he was no ordinary child, and they were not afraid of the king's edict. By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh's daughter. He chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the fleeting pleasures of sin. 4 Most Important Choices in My Life!

Choice #1 – Refuse to be defined by anyone but God

Hebrews 11:24 (NIV)

By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh's daughter.

Exodus 23:1-3 (MSG)

"Don't link up with a wicked person and give corrupt testimony. Don't go along with the crowd in doing evil and don't fudge your testimony in a case just to please the crowd. And just because someone is poor, don't show favoritism in a dispute."

1 Thessalonians 2:4 (NLT)

For we speak as messengers approved by God to be entrusted with the Good News. Our purpose is to please God, not people. He alone examines the motives of our hearts.

Jeremiah 29:11 (NLT)

"For I know the plans I have for you," says the LORD. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope."

Choice #2 – Remember a momentary loss can result in a miraculous life

Hebrews 11:25 (NIV)

He chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the fleeting pleasures of sin.

Romans 5:3-4 (NCV)

We also have joy with our troubles, because we know that these troubles produce patience. And patience produces character, and character produces hope.

2 Corinthians 4:17-18 (NLT)

For our present troubles are small and won't last very long. Yet they produce for us a glory that vastly outweighs them and will last forever! So we don't look at the troubles we can see now; rather, we fix our gaze on things that cannot be seen. For the things we see now will soon be gone, but the things we cannot see will last forever.

Choice #3 – Regard God’s purposes above the world’s pleasures

Hebrews 11:26 (NIV)

He regarded disgrace for the sake of Christ as of greater value than the treasures of Egypt, because he was looking ahead to his reward.

1 John 2:16-17 (NIV)

For everything in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—comes not from the Father but from the world. The world and its desires pass away, but whoever does the will of God lives forever.

Luke 6:22-23 (TPT)

“How favored you become when you are hated, excommunicated, or slandered, or when your name is spoken of as evil because of your love for me, the son of man. I promise you that as you experience these things, you will celebrate and dance with overflowing joy. And the heavenly reward of your faith will be abundant, because you are being treated the same way as your forefathers the prophets.”

2 Keys to Regarding God’s Purposes

- **People are more valuable than my personal pleasure.**
- **Peace of mind is more valuable than earthly possessions.**

Choice #4 – Reject my fears and release my faith

Hebrews 11:27 (NIV)

By faith he left Egypt, not fearing the king’s anger; he persevered because he saw him who is invisible.

Psalms 27:1-4 (TPT)

The Lord is my revelation-light to guide me along the way; he’s the source of my salvation to defend me every day. I fear no one! I’ll never turn back and run from you, Lord; surround and protect me. When evil ones come to destroy me, they will be the ones who turn back. My heart will not be afraid even if an army rises to attack. I know that you are there for me, so I will not be shaken. Here’s the one thing I crave from God, the one thing I seek above all else: I want the privilege of living with him every moment in his house, finding the sweet loveliness of his face, filled with awe, delighting in his glory and grace. I want to live my life so close to him that he takes pleasure in my every prayer.

Galatians 2:16 (CEV)

But we know that God accepts only those who have faith in Jesus Christ. No one can please God by simply obeying the Law. So we put our faith in Christ Jesus, and God accepted us because of our faith.
