4 Undeniable Facts About the Resurrection:

• Thomas was an unbeliever until he saw the resurrected Jesus.

John 20:25, 27-28 (TPT)

"Still unconvinced, Thomas replied, 'There's no way I'm going to believe this unless I personally see the wounds of the nails in his hands, touch them with my finger, and put my hand into the wound of his side where he was pierced!'...Then, looking into Thomas' eyes, he said, 'Put your finger here in the wounds of my hands. Here—put your hand into my wounded side and see for yourself. Thomas, don't give in to your doubts any longer, just believe!' Then the words spilled out of his heart—'You are my Lord, and you are my God!'"

• <u>James</u> did not believe his half-brother to be Lord until the resurrection.

John 7:5 (TPT)

"His brothers were pushing him, even though they didn't yet believe in him as the Savior."

• <u>515</u> witnesses who lost their faith at the crucifixion, saw Jesus after his resurrection. (They ate with him, walked with him, talked with him and were transformed.)

1 Corinthians 15:6 (TPT)

"He also appeared to more than five hundred of his followers at the same time, most of whom are still alive as I write this, though a few have passed away."

• <u>I</u> have personally experienced transformation and witnessed the transformation of countless lives through the power of my resurrected Lord.

Jesus' Resurrection Gives Believers 6 Hopeful Promises:



The promise that we have been completely forgiven.

Ephesians 1:7 (ICB)

"In Christ we are set free by the blood of his death. And so we have forgiveness of sins because of God's rich grace."

Who put Jesus on the cross?

Twofold answer:

• First - God did.

Isaiah 53:6-10 (NLT)

"All of us, like sheep, have strayed away. We have left God's paths to follow our own. Yet the LORD laid on him the sins of us all. He was oppressed and treated harshly, yet he never said a word. He was led like a lamb to the slaughter. And as a sheep is silent before the shearers, he did not open his mouth. Unjustly condemned, he was led away. No one cared that he died without descendants, that his life was cut short in midstream. But he was struck down for the rebellion of my people. He had done no wrong and had never deceived anyone. But he was buried like a criminal; he was put in a rich man's grave. But it was the LORD's good plan to crush him and cause him grief. Yet when his life is made an offering for sin, he will have many descendants. He will enjoy a long life, and the LORD's good plan will prosper in his hands."

• Second - We did!
