1 Second birth.

John 3:3-7 (CEV)

"Jesus replied, 'I tell you for certain that you must be born from above before you can see God's kingdom!' Nicodemus asked, 'How can a grown man ever be born a second time?' Jesus answered: I tell you for certain that before you can get into God's kingdom, you must be born not only by water, but by the Spirit. Humans give life to their children. Yet only God's Spirit can change you into a child of God. Don't be surprised when I say that you must be born from above."

- **As a non-believer: born once, die twice.**
- **As a child of God: born twice, die once.**

2 Spiritual growth.

- **Salvation - "A gift received by faith in Jesus Christ's death, burial and resurrection alone without any action on my part" = Eternity with Jesus.**
- **Sanctification - "Obedience in response to my salvation produced by practicing spiritual disciplines while yielding to the Holy Spirit" = A temporary life of fulfilling God's purposes.**
