

Walking Right in a Wrong-Way World July 3-4, 2021

Hebrews 11:6-7 (ICB)

Without faith no one can please God. Anyone who comes to God must believe that he is real and that he rewards those who truly want to find him. It was by faith Noah heard God's warnings about things that he could not yet see. He obeyed God and built a large boat to save his family. By his faith, Noah showed that the world was wrong. And he became one of those who are made right with God through faith.

Romans 2:5 (ICB)

But you are hard and stubborn and refuse to change. So you are making your own punishment greater and greater on the day God shows his anger. On that day all people will see God's right judgments.

What was Noah's World Like?

• It was a world that had broken God's heart.

Genesis 6:5-6 (NLT)

The LORD observed the extent of human wickedness on the earth, and he saw that everything they thought or imagined was consistently and totally evil. So the LORD was sorry he had ever made them and put them on the earth. It broke his heart.

Hebrew "Asav" = "It hurt his heart like childhood hurts a mother."

• It was a world of <u>unrestrained</u> sinfulness.

Genesis 6:5b (NLT)

"Every thought and intent of man's heart was continually evil."

• It was a world of <u>unrelenting</u> violence.

Genesis 6:11-12 (MSG)

As far as God was concerned, the Earth had become a sewer; there was violence everywhere. God took one look and saw how bad it was, everyone corrupt and corrupting—life itself corrupt to the core.

• It was a world of unaware living.

Genesis 6:13 (MSG)

God said to Noah, "It's all over. It's the end of the human race. The violence is everywhere; I'm making a clean sweep."

"The Arrival of the Son of Man will take place in times like Noah's. Before the great flood everyone was carrying on as usual, having a good time right up to the day Noah boarded the ark. They knew nothing—until the flood hit and swept everything away."

Find favor by trusting in God's grace alone.

Genesis 6:8 (AMP)

These are the records of the generations (family history) of Noah. Noah was a righteous man [one who was just and had right standing with God], blameless in his [evil] generation;

• <u>Blameless</u>: mature; unable to be accused of wrongdoing.

Philippians 2:15-16 (ESV)

...that you may be blameless and innocent, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and twisted generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, holding fast to the word of life, so that in the day of Christ I may be proud that I did not run in vain or labor in vain.

Focus on one obedient step of Faith.

Hebrews 11:7 (TPT)

But he stepped out in reverent obedience to God and built an ark that would save him and his family.
