1 Timothy 2:1-4 (TPT)

It is pleasing to our Savior-God to pray for them. He longs for everyone to embrace his life and return to the full knowledge of the truth.

Colossians 2:2-3 (NIV)

My goal is that they may be encouraged in heart and united in love, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely, Christ, in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

- The first great awakening (1730-1740)

Two Ways to Start a Great Awakening:

- Make a harvest <u>list</u> Write down the names of unsaved family, friends, co-workers, classmates, or neighbors God lays on my heart.
- **Pray every day for their <u>salvation</u>** Start each day for 10 minutes praying for them.

I must prepare the fields around me.

1 Corinthians 3:6-9 (TPT)

I planted the seed, and Apollos watered it, but God made it grow. So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God who makes things grow. The one who plants and the one who waters have one purpose, and they will each be rewarded according to their own labor. We are coworkers belonging to God. You are God's cultivated garden, the house he is building.

Prepared field = people feel <u>seen</u>, welcomed, and loved.

4 Ways to Prepare the Fields

- In my <u>home</u> I will make my home a place of peace, forgiveness, and encouragement.
- In my <u>relationships</u> I will listen more, judge less, and show grace.
- In my <u>church</u> I will not just attend, I will serve, smile, greet, and love.
- In my <u>social media</u> world I will post and respond in ways that reflect Jesus.
